## Habit 3: Put First Things First

Habit 3: Put First Things First means to set priorities, make a schedule, and achieve goals. This is often hard to do in our busy lives. Taking a few minutes each week just to sit down and think about the week ahead can actually save us time as our week progresses. This is a great family WIG (Wildly Important Just a simple calendar Goal) with important activities written down can teach children the importance of planning and time management. Some tips for weekly planning are:

When: Before the week begins.

Where? Someplace quiet How long? 20-30 minutes

Another way to Put Things First is to avoid needless interruptions, unimportant phone calls, mail, and e-mail. Also many hours a day on video games, TV, and the internet can often keep us from doing the things that matter most.

If students learn to do their work first, then they will be able to enjoy these activities. The Very Hungry Caterpillar is a book that illustrates what it means to put first things first.
