

Big Rocks Little Rocks:

Attached you will find an interactive flipchart you can use and/or choose to watch a video on the end slide.

If you would like, you can even do the big rock little rock activity in your class to always have a visual reminder in the classroom. – Included is a guideline of ideas to conduct in your classroom if this is the route you choose!

Here is a movie (about 3 minutes long) that some of the older kids can watch. Younger ones can view this as well but will need some narrating as it plays. I included two links, just in case one works better than the other. Some of it is geared towards adults, such as “Play with your children” You can talk about what that would mean for their age instead, such as “Play with your siblings”, etc.
